- Location:** Rodbaston College, Penkridge. Stafford. ST19 5PH.
- Date:** Sunday 22nd August 2010.
- Judges:** Chairman of Judges - Pam Jones.
- Rounds:** FITA 70M & 60M and Team Head to Head at 70M.
- Timing:** 9:15am, practice, Commence shooting at 10:00am Archers will have their lunch break at the end of the FITA 70M, any shoot-offs will be shot during the lunch break, and archers must be prepared for this.
- Awards:** According to entry for Recurve, Compound and Longbow.
- Teams:** Rec & Comp, 3 Archers per team. Longbow, 2 Archers per team.
- Dress:** GNAS dress regulations will apply. The tournament is open to any archer currently affiliated to the GNAS.
- Drug Testing:** Archers will be liable for drug testing, and archers approached must comply. If they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Entries from archers under 18 must be signed by a parent/guardian to signify their consent to their child being drug tested if approached.
- Photography:** Those who wish to take photographs or video must register with the Tournament Secretary on the morning of the shoot. No unauthorised photography will be permitted.
- GNAS Cards:** Archers will be required to have their membership cards available.
